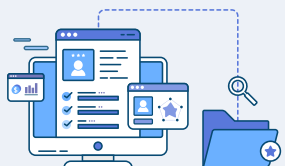

Online courses

You can take part in top-notch online Korean language programs provided by Kyung Hee University's Institute of International Education without entering Korea.

Regular Online Courses

Regular online courses are for foreigners and overseas Koreans who are 18 years or older. The courses run for ten weeks in Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter. Students can take high-quality Korean language courses through our online platform from anywhere in the world.

Intensive Online Courses

Online intensive courses are for foreigners or overseas Koreans who are 18 years or older. Students study Korean language and culture intensively during the Spring or Summer sessions. There are 3-week and 6-week courses. The 3-week course focuses on Korean grammar and speaking activities, and the 6-week course focuses on grammar and reading/writing.

Special Online Courses

The special course is a program where you can learn Korean with focus on grammar and conversation by topics. This course is especially useful for those who do not have the time to study during the week as it is offered online in the evening and on weekends. It is recommended that beginners complete the Korean Alphabet (Hangeul) Course before taking the beginner level.

Academic Calender for Korean Language Programs



Program Overview

The Korean language courses are operated according to the needs and levels of learners. The basic focus of Korean classes is communication-oriented and aims for integrated development of grammar, speaking, listening, reading, and writing. It runs a Korean language helper system (dowoomi) where students can practice conversation and exchange culture with Kyung Hee University students. The Korean language course is divided into regular (10 weeks), intensive (6 weeks), and short-term (3 weeks) programs, and the regular course is operated as a Korean studies course and divided into 6 stages– beginner (I-II), intermediate (I-II), and advanced (I-II)– and a preparatory course for college (or graduate school) enrollment. Short-term courses (three-week intensive courses) are operated during the spring semester (March) and summer semester (August and September).

Regular Courses

[10 weeks]

- 10 weeks per semester, 4 semesters per year.
- Provides a systematic and intimate communication-oriented classroom environment
- Provides useful and fun cultural classes such as Taekwondo, Danso (short bamboo flute), Barista Experience, Fire Station Experience, etc.
- Conducts various field trips to experience Korean history and culture
- Club activities where students from other countries can interact

Intensive Courses

[6 weeks]

- February–March, August–September twice a year for 6 weeks
- A short intensive course to improve communication skills
- TOPIK classes are offered to help prepare for and pass the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK)
- Various experiences and programs, including cultural classes such as Taekwondo and K-POP dance, and two field trips, are offered

Short-term Courses

[3 weeks]

- Three times a year in March, August, and September for three weeks
- Provides an intensive communication-oriented classroom environment
- Cultural classes such as Korean songs, dramas, traditional games, etiquette, etc. are offered
- Experience Korean Traditional and Modern Culture through Field Trips (2 times)

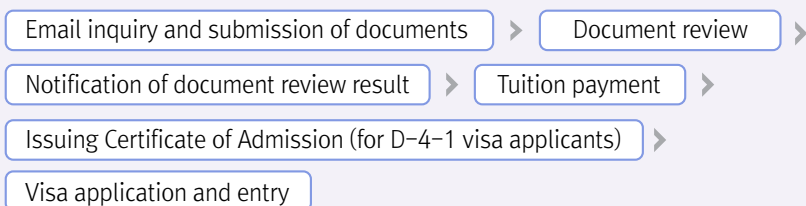

Subjects

- Foreigners over the age of 18 and overseas Koreans

- Application for admission (inquiry and registration by e-mail), 1 ID photo, 1 copy of passport, proof of final academic background.
- ※ Three-week courses are only available for students from visa agreement countries.
- ※ Documents which were submitted will not be returned.
- ※ Documents to be submitted may differ by country, so please contact us by e-mail for detailed instructions.

Issuing Certificate of Admission

- Only those who have applied for a regular course for 2 semesters or more will be issued a Certificate of Admission after confirming payment of tuition.
- Applicants for one semester of the regular course and applicants for short-term courses will not be issued a Certificate of Admission.
- The Certificate of Admission cannot be used for purposes other than issuance of visas.

You can learn and play the danso, a traditional Korean instrument made of bamboo, and understand Korean traditional music.

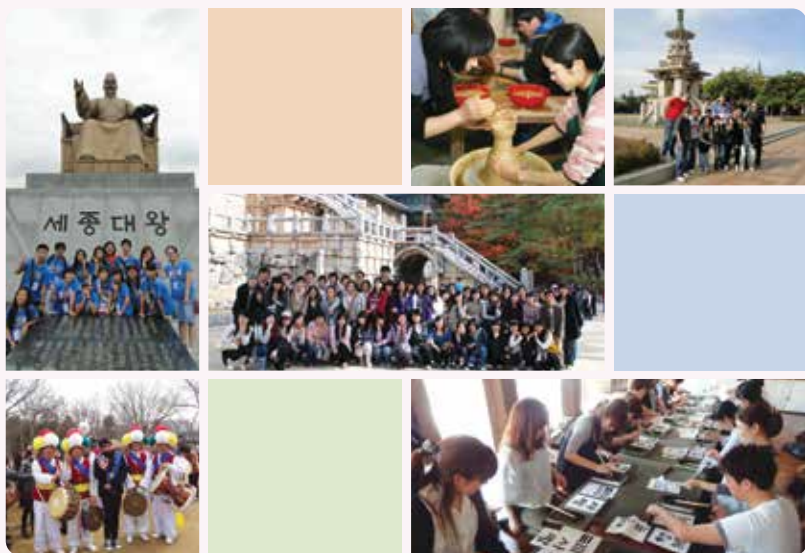


K-pop Dance Club

Dormitory

The Institute of International Education operates dormitories off-campus for foreign students. Since the dormitory is near Hoegi Station, it is easy to use convenient facilities and move around Seoul city. You can choose a single room (Richville, Chang Deok Ahn) or a double room (Chang Deok Ahn), and the dormitory room is equipped with wired and wireless internet, a washing machine, refrigerator, air conditioner, desk, and closet. World Korean Language Speech Contest for Foreigners

In 1998, the Institute of International Education held the first Korean speaking contest for foreigners in Korean universities and has been holding it every year. Foreigners from all over the world participate in the event covering various themes on Korean language and Korean culture, and prizes such as the Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism Award and Kyung Hee University President's Award are awarded to the best. The Korean language speaking contest is reported through YouTube, TV broadcasts, and newspapers. Through Korean language, Koreans and people from all over the world understand and connect with each other, contributing to the globalization of the Korean language.


Introduction to Korean Language Textbooks

‘Kyung Hee Korean’ is the latest textbook, completed in 2020, and consists of 19 books divided into 6 levels including Beginner 1, 2, Intermediate 1, 2, Advanced 1, 2, etc. The textbooks for each level are divided into three volumes: grammar, listening speaking, reading and writing. In particular, ‘Kyung Hee Korean First Step’ has been published separately for beginners to learn Korean and first-time learners can learn Korean easily and in a fun way. In addition, as the grammar section is published as a separate textbook, it allows learners to systematically study Korean grammar. In addition, listening, speaking, reading and writing textbooks are also published as separate textbooks, so you can improve your Korean communication skills in an organic and integrated way. The entire volume of ‘Kyung Hee Korean’ is published as paper books and e-books. E-books also have MP3 files or video clips (movies) which can be played. Also, functions such as taking notes and searching can be used to assist learning. E-books with multimedia and learning aids help you learn Korean more effectively. For paper books, you can scan the QR code in the textbook or download multimedia files from the Kyung Hee Korean website (klb.khu.ac.kr) to use MP3 files and video clips.
